Program

The Hoosier Star Awards program is a critique service for high school newspapers and yearbooks. It provides all participants with feedback in time to make improvements in the last two months of the school year. It also identifies outstanding publications in the state of Indiana, giving scholastic journalism the recognition it deserves. Winners of the Hoosier Star Awards will be announced in the summer edition of the Press Review and through press releases sent throughout the state.

Entry

1. Fill out the attached form.
2. Newspaper entries should include any three consecutive issues published since the beginning of the current school year. Yearbook entries should include the latest book published (in most cases, the 2001 yearbook).

Cost

The entry fee is \$25. Checks should be made out to IHSPA.

Deadline

Yearbook entries must be postmarked by November 15, 2003 Newspaper entries must be postmarked by January 19, 2004.

Judging

Entries will be judged by educators or professional journalists who have been or are currently involved in scholastic journalism. Current Indiana advisers are excluded. Judges will rate the publications according to criteria set by the IHSPA and critique booklets containing evaluations and comments will be returned with the publications. The Hoosier Star Awards will be given to publications earning the most points. A third judge will determine the Hoosier Star publications from among schools who have been scored as "Superior" or "Excellent."
