Cost

The state associaton's journalism workshop has been designed to provide an optimum experience at a reasonable price, \$250 per student or adviser for 4 activity-packed days. The workshop fee includes most meals and air-conditioned dorm accommodations.

Format

The student experience begins with people skills: working with diverse personalities, fostering team atmospheres, working in partnership with advisers, and conflict management. Then, students move to teaching / leadership skills every editor should know. Finally, your editors practice their team skills. In one day, student teams will pull together an entire story package page, including stories based on actual interviews, digital photography and design based on Quark Xpress or Pagemaker. This unique project has included daytrips to downtown Franklin and the Indianapolis Zoo in the past. This year, students will head to Nashville in Brown County to find their photos and stories.
