* Keep in mind...students are leaving the First Amendment behind! How can YOU get them excited about their freedoms?

We will narrow the submissions down from each category and forward the best projects to the IHSPA for judging. Your project could win a prize and be recognized at the First Amendment Symposium on March 3, 2010!

Option 1

Design First Amendment Postage Stamps

- Must be 5 different stamps relating to the 5 freedoms of the First Amendment.
- Must be designed on an 8.5x11 size document.
- Must be saved as a jpeg or PDF in the Final Exam folder on the server.
- Could possibly end up on your envelopes one day!

Option 2

Write An Essay

- Must be between 250 and 500 words.
- Should reflect on how the First Amendment has affected your life in some way.
- Should be typed, double spaced and 12 pt. font.
- Must be saved as a Word file in the Final Exam folder on the server.
- Could be published in the First Amendment Symposium official program for all to see!

Option 3

Design a First Amendment Poster

- Must be designed on an 11x17 size document.
- Can be horizontal or vertical.
- The poster should promote the First Amendment and its freedoms.
- The poster should cater to a teenage audience.
- Must be saved as a jpeg or PDF in the Final Exam folder on the server.
- Could possibly be mass produced and hung in journalism rooms across the nation!
